

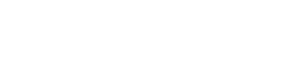
★ The Top 5 User Rated Learning Management Systems

★ How Products Are Scored

Products are scored based on user reviews measuring how satisfied users are with a product overall. The scoring includes ratings from reviews within a 12-month analysis period; products must have at least 10 reviews within the analysis period to be eligible. The methodology calculates the percentile ranking for each product relative to all other products in the software category that have qualified for inclusion; that percentile ranking is then translated into a final score.
